

BIN SALES

All competing artists may submit up to 10 pieces for bin sale (not to be judged) and the price of each piece may not exceed \$150.00. Bin prices must be in even dollar amounts ending in zero, with the name, address, price and media on the back of each matted piece or on the bottom of each piece of sculpture or other 3-D art. Sets of pottery will be accepted as one item. All work must be protected with acetate and marked original or print. Zonta will retain a 30% commission on all sales.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

For the ninth year, the Zonta Club of Cañon City is proud to sponsor a judged art show featuring women artists. This year the exhibition is separated into two divisions: advanced artist and emerging artist. The emerging artist division is divided into 4 categories with cash prizes in each category. The advanced division is not split into categories, but cash prizes will be awarded for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place.

DELIVERY OF ARTWORK

Work must arrive at the Colorado National Guard Armory on Wednesday, October 8 between 12pm and 4 pm. Shipped works must arrive prepaid in a reusable container and must include payment for return shipping including insurance. Ship works to: Sharon Brookins, 700 Macon Ave., Canon City, CO 81212.

RETURN OF ARTWORK

Following the close of the exhibition, entries for return shipment will be repacked in original container and shipped. Return shipments will be insured for the sale price unless otherwise noted. All hand delivered entries must be picked up on Monday, October 13 between 12pm and 4pm. Artwork not claimed on this day will be donated to the Rialto Theater Restoration Project unless prior arrangements have been made.

PRESENTATION

All entries must be professionally framed or properly prepared for display. Artwork with clip mounts, missing wires or sawtooth hangers will not be accepted or hung. Jewelry and other small work must be in wall-hung or pedestal locked display cases, including bin items. Failure to comply will result in work not displayed and entry fees forfeited.

All submitted artwork must be identified with name, address, phone number, division, category, title, price or NFS. 2-D work must be identified on back and 3-D work identified on bottom with securely attached labels.

SALES

Zonta Club will retain a 30% commission on all sales.

LIABILITY

It is suggested that the artist carry their own insurance. All reasonable care will be given to the artwork—however the Zonta Club of Cañon City will not be responsible for loss or damage, however caused. Your signature on the entry form constitutes agreement with these terms and conditions.
