Related goals for clubs in District 12:

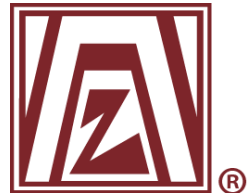
Goal 1 – Programs and Projects: emphasis on education for girls (ZI scholarships and projects)

- each club should have at least one Advocacy project - including elimination of violence against women



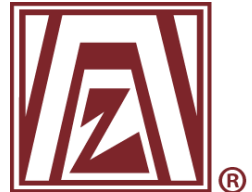
2. MEMBERSHIP

- ZI shall support future leaders, professional development



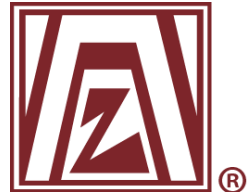
Goal 2 – Membership: Retention is key, emphasis on recruiting award winners, District should hold an event to honor them. Each club should:
