- 2. A number of clubs have updated their on-line information and added material to promote club communication and outreach to the community and new members.
- 3. D12 has used the web site for conference promoting and registration links.
- 4. The web has been used to work with the D12 board to promote various activities and Zonta mission-related programs within our District, Zonta International and globally.
- The new website utilizes Google Calendar, Facebook feed and a Blog for timely distribution of information.






