

Emma L. Conlon Service Awards Program Background/Statistics January 2014

Purpose

Z Clubs and Golden Z clubs help high school, college and university students develop leadership skills, promote career exploration and encourage members to participate in community, school and international service projects.

The Award

The Emma L. Conlon Service Awards for Z clubs and Golden Z clubs recognizes those clubs whose projects and programs best express the ideals of Zonta International through local and International service and advocacy to advance the status of women worldwide. These awards are given annually to three Z clubs and three Golden Z clubs based on applications submitted for review and judging by the International Z and Golden Z club Committee. The Emma L. Conlon Award money must be used for the club's service projects. In February, each award recipient reports to Zonta International as to how the award money was spent.

Program Statistics

Since the inception of the Emma L. Conlon Awards program in 1961, there have been 197 Awards total given to Z clubs and Golden Z clubs. There are currently 194 Z Clubs and 74 Golden Z Clubs in 21 countries around the world.
