In such a world, no woman lives in fear of violence.




Zonta History

- 1930 Zonta Confederation became Zonta International with the first European club in Vienna, Austria
- 1928 Zonta opens national headquarters in Chicago
- 1948 First South American Club (Chile)
- 1952 First Asian Club (Philippines)
- 1965 First New Zealand Club
- 1966 First Australia Club
- 1970 First African Club (Ghana)
- 1977 Lakewood/Golden Club is Established!!




Zonta Membership Global Reach

International Service Program 2010-2012 Projects

Since 1923, Zonta has provided more than US\$9.8 million to projects benefiting more than 2 million women in 34 countries.

During the 2010-2012 Biennium, three projects are being supported by the International Service Program Fund:

- Prevention of Mother to Child Transmission of HIV and Gender-Based Violence in Rwanda - Funding: US\$500,000 to UNICEF (United Nations Children's Fund)
- Safe Cities for Women Project in Guatemala City, Guatemala and San Salvador, El Salvador - Funding: US\$500,000 to UNIFEM (United Nations Development Fund for Women)
- Elimination of Obstetric Fistula and the Reduction of Maternal and Newborn Mortality and Morbidity in Liberia - Funding: US\$500,000 to UNFPA (United Nations Population Fund)
