

Friday, September 23, 2016

WELCOME & CALL TO ORDER: Governor Reneé Coppock called the meeting to order at 2:03 PM on Friday, September 23, 2016. The meeting was held at the Homestead Visitor's Center in Lead, South Dakota.

Guests: Governor Reneé introduced Bridget Masters, ZI Treasurer; Jacqueline Gudmundsen, ZI Leadership Development Committee member and liaison to District 12; Kay Meyer, Member of ZI International Foundation Development Committee, Past ZI Advocacy Committee Chairman (2012-2014) and Past District 12 Governor (2010-2012); and Olette Stanberry who will be working with Sheila Davis on leadership training.

Governor Reneé introduced her Leadership team and Past District 12 Governors: Judy Allen (1998-2000) and Priscilla Romkema (2008-2010).

Agenda Amended: Governor Renee added an agenda item to vote on a reduction in District dues to match the new ZI provision relating to new members under the age of 30.

Transitional Board Minutes: Governor Reneé asked to approve the Transitional Board minutes, June 3 & 4, 2016 by consensus. Minutes approved.

Zonta International Convention Report: A brief report was given by attendees, including Jackie Gudmundsen, who will attend our Dist. 12 Conference.

Treasures Report: Treasurer Terri Otley reported that most expenses have been paid. She is still working on expenses for International. There are no outstanding bills as of June 1st. Terri reminded us to fill out the Expense Reimbursement form even if you are going to donate your expenses. Deedee Boysen reported that we had grown by 60 members in the last Biennium. Handouts included: Fund Balances June through August 2016, Operations Budget Comparison, Budget to Actual and the Expense Reimbursement form.

OLD BUSINESS

Smart Goals: Governor Reneé emphasized the benefits of using S.M.A.R.T. goals that are Specific, Measurable, Attainable, Realistic and Timely and asked the team to redo their goals and return them before October 15 with their Outreach article. The article for the Outreach should be one to two paragraphs.

Open Position: Governor Reneé said we need to find a Chair for Internal Communications.

NEW BUSINESS

Leadership Training: Sheila Davis handed out the Training and Leadership Development goals and expressed how helpful it was to have Olette Stanberry as an advisor. Shelia emphasized how important it was to have everyone's input on how effective the trainings were to participants. Comments and future changes:

One hour trainings were too long.

Participants wanted to be able to report on the training.

It was frustrating when trainings were cancelled with no advance notice.

Trainings were available after they had been in their position for several months.

There is lots of help on the ZI website.

Goals: by 1/1/17 have an evaluation/feedback in place that will be anonymous.

Have trainings in April/May.

Have a blended training: face to face/classroom /videos/ on line but continue with the conference calls.

Suggestions:

Provide a go to person for participants to ask questions.

Promote trainings through Area Meetings and contact club chairman of training dates. Provide tidbit follow ups.

Break trainings to 15 minute segments.

Obtain trainings from other Districts and put them ZI website.

Education Fund Review Committee: Governor Reneé asked who was on the Education Fund Committee. According to the P & P Manual, the Governor appoints no less than 3 on the committee one of whom is an Area Director. The committee members consist of Terri Otley, Marcy O'Toole and Area 3 Director Michelle Médal.
