Arriving by Plane:



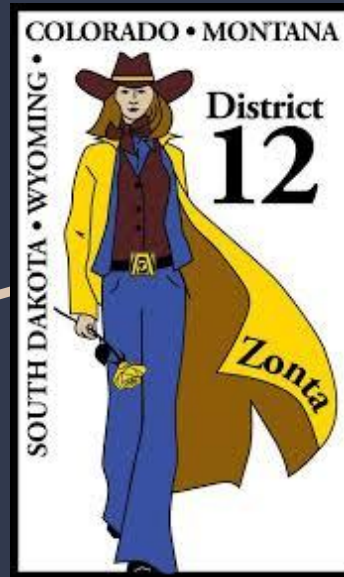
- The Chicago Marriott Downtown Magnificent Mile is located 15 miles from O'Hare Airport, or 12 miles from Chicago Midway Airport. The hotel does not provide shuttle service.
- Alternate transportation:
 - Go Airport Express - \$27 (One way)
 - Taxi - \$40 (one way)
 - Subway \$2.25 (one way)

Cancellations & Refunds:

- After June 30: No refund



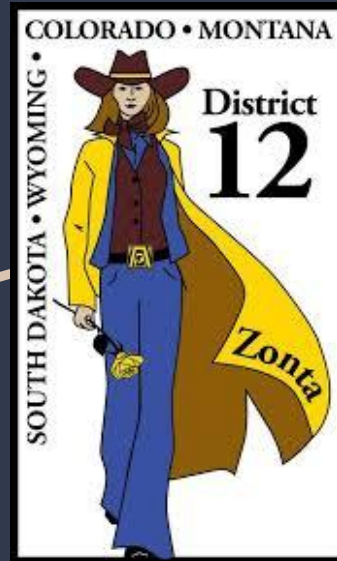
Climate:



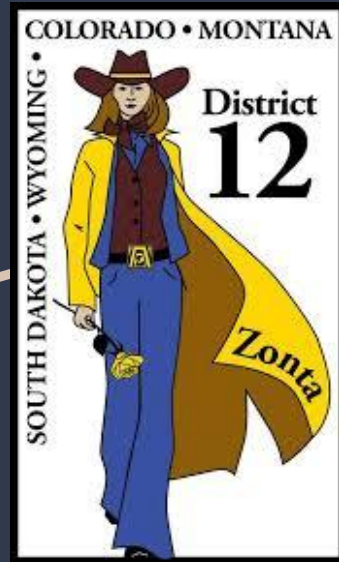
- You can expect the temperature in Chicago to be between 70 and 80 degrees. You can also expect it to be humid.

- Coffee/tea breaks for select events are included in the cost of registration.

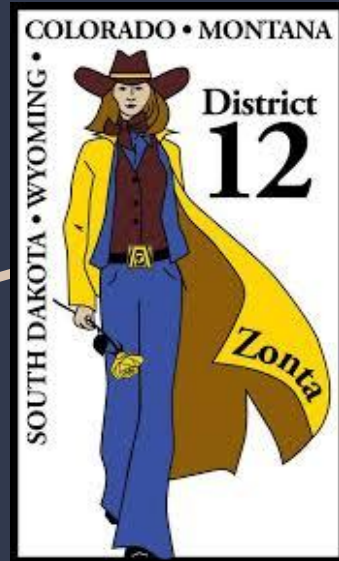
