Dear Zonta friends,

Debbie and I would like to invite you to join us at the 2019 District 12 Conference in Billings, MT this September. The conference will be held on September 20 - 22 at the Billings Hotel and Convention Center. The Zonta Club of Billings Host Committee, led by Debbie Sundberg, Conference Chair, and your District 12 Leadership Team have planned a very full weekend of Zonta events and activities that we hope will inform and inspire you to *Seize the Zonta Spirit* to support and empower women in your own communities as well as around the world as we move into the next century of Zonta!

The conference will celebrate our Centennial with a look at Zonta's accomplishments from 1919 to 2019 and beyond. The following gives a few of the highlights you can expect at the Conference.



Friday afternoon. Arrive before 3:00 PM to take a tour and enjoy wine tasting at the Yellowstone Cellars and Winery, which is just a few blocks from the Conference hotel. A hotel shuttle will take you to and from the winery.

Friday at 5:00 PM. There will be a First Timers Orientation at the hotel. If this is your first time attending a District Conference, you should plan to attend.

Friday at 5:45 PM. Busses will take Zontians to an exhibit at the MSU Billings Student Union to view "What Were You Wearing?" - a survivor art presentation. The busses will transport Zontians at 6:45 PM to Prescott Hall at the Rocky Mountain College to attend the *Let the Party Begin* Welcome Reception. Zontians are asked to dress in period costume of your favorite inspiring woman, or to wear white to symbolize support of the suffrage movement. Bring an amazing handbag to show off, and gather with friends old and new to create a fascinator to dress up your costume. Prizes will be awarded for best costume, fascinator, and handbag. Greeley Zontian and Legendary Lady Kathy Swafford will entertain us with a presentation on Zonta's history, and busses will return us to the hotel at 9:15 PM.

Saturday at 7:00 AM. Billings Zontian and Fitness Trainer Susie Debar will lead the Zonta Morning Exercise. Meet in the hotel lobby and dress in comfortable clothes.

Saturday at 7:30 AM. A Continental Breakfast is provided, followed by shopping at the Zonta Store, or a stroll down the North Foyer to enjoy the club history displays. The registration and credentials check-in will also be open and will be located in the North Foyer.

Saturday at 8:00 AM. An instructional meeting for delegates, alternates and voting Board Members will be offered by District 12 Bylaws and Resolutions Chair Ann Hefenieder. All Zontians who are voting must attend.

Saturday at 9:00 AM. A very packed business session starts. Voting will be held on financial statements, the 2020 - 2022 budget, District 12 amendments/changes to the policies and procedures, and the 2020 - 2022 Slate of Officers. Leadership training and workshops will be held in the afternoon. You will be asked to pick one of four sessions to attend. You will have a chance to attend another workshop on Sunday.

Saturday coffee breaks. Check out the Zonta Store to find a new "must have" Zonta item. All clubs are invited to sell their wares at the Zonta Store. Raffle tickets will also be sold for the District 12 Scholarship basket, to raise money in support of our scholarships, and for the Wall of Wine, which is a fundraiser in support of Zonta International Service Projects.



The wines are donated by the D12 Leadership Team and the entire "wall" goes to one raffle ticket holder at the end of the conference. A club history display will also be offered in the North Foyer.

Saturday at 12:30 PM. Sigrid Duden, Zonta International Director and District 12 Liaison will address "Leadership and Empowerment" during lunch. She will be followed by Rachel Steinberg, UNICEF USA Program Director, who will address Zonta's "Ending Child Marriage" Project.

Saturday at 3:00 PM. Zonta International Director Sigrid Duden will offer an informal conversation on topics of interest to Zontians. Questions from the audience will be received and responded to by Sigrid.

Saturday at 6:00 PM. Reception and cocktails are followed by presentations from the 2018 Zonta International and District 12 Jane M. Klausman award winner, Cassidy Shaver, and the District 12 Centennial Award winner, Dr. Ray Fleming Dinneen, founder and leader of ClimbWyoming, a program of empowerment for low income single mothers to discover self sufficiency through career training and placement. The District 12 Award Ceremony, emceed

by Lt. Governor Ann Hodgson, will follow. Fellowship with Governor Deedee and ZI Director Sigrid Duden will close out the evening.

Sunday at 7:45 AM. There will be a Memorial Service to honor District 12 Zontians who passed away in the period between September 2017 and September 2019.

Sunday at 9:00 AM. Enjoy Brunch, and a closing presentation by Rachel Steinberg on the Let Us Learn Madagascar project. We will also hear an update on the Centennial Anniversary Endowment Fund and the Zonta International Foundation. Four workshops will be held after brunch - choose your favorite! The conference will conclude at noon.

Workshops

Four workshops will be offered by District 12 leaders. Zontians will have the opportunity to attend two of the four workshops.

Emotionally Intelligent Leadership for Women will be presented by Marian Lee. The most effective leaders have a high degree of emotional intelligence, which includes self awareness, self regulation, motivation, empathy, and social skills. In this workshop, we will examine the emotional intelligence competencies, how to develop them, and how to leverage them to increase your effectiveness as a leader.

Marian Lee is an attorney and certified executive and leadership coach. She has over thirty years of experience in counseling clients, building and managing law practices, holding leadership positions in non-profit organizations, and providing training and coaching to professionals. She's been a member of the Zonta Club of Denver for six years, and served as its President from 2018 to 2019.

Zonta's Partnership with the UN: Why it is important and Zonta International's role at the Commission on the Status of Women will be presented by Renee L. Coppock, ZI Bylaws and Resolutions Chair and District 12 UN Chair. Learn how Zonta International's partnership with the United Nations empowers women around the globe and gain a better understanding of ZI's role and importance at the Commission on the Status of Women. Join the discussion to determine how Zonta can better empower women at the NGO CSW. Need a primer on the acronyms? We can provide it!

Renee has been a member of the Zonta Club of Billings since 1996 and has served many roles at the club and district levels, including past District 12 Governor, past club president, past Area 1 Director, and is currently the Zonta International Bylaws and Resolutions Chair and District 12 United Nations Chair. She has attended 7 Commissions on the Status of Women, 4 North American Interdistrict Meetings, and 4 Zonta International Conventions. She is passionate about promoting Zonta and its mission and believes that Zonta's partnership with the UN is essential to the success of ZI's projects and missions.

Ending Child Marriage: Obstacles and Experiences will be presented by Denise Parrish and will discuss many of the reasons that have been heard for *not* enacting a minimum age for marrying and appropriate responses to those objections. Use this session as an opportunity to prepare to discuss this issue with legislators and to educate the members of your community about the problems associated with child marriage.

Denise Parrish has been a Zontian for ten years but has been passionate about equality for women since she was a teenager. She has been the District 12 Advocacy Chair for over three years, and is a member of the Zonta USA Advocacy Caucus. In her day job, she is the Deputy Administrator of the Wyoming Office of Consumer Advocate, where she is encouraged to have a healthy skepticism and to question everything put in front of her. She has traveled to more than 25 countries on a volunteer basis training others in governmental oversight of utilities.

Engaging Zonta Club Members will be presented by Kathy Cathcart. Congratulations! You were successful getting someone to join your club. Now what? Oh Boy! Your club has a *few* members that aren't contributing. What to do? This will be interactive session on how to engage club members. We'll use the infamous 'magic wall' to share and brainstorm ideas, and discuss best practices of member engagement.

Kathy Cathcart has been a Zontian for 14 years. She has been the Cheyenne club's president twice and the treasurer. She understands the importance of club members that see value in what they and their clubs do. Kathy's professional experience is in planning, consulting, training and business services as the President and managing Director of Align. Align's mission is creating strong communities by partnering with nonprofits, government and businesses for more impactful, successful organizations and programs.

D12 Centennial Anniversary Award Winner

Our District 12 Centennial Anniversary Award Winner is Dr. Ray Fleming Dineen, who was nominated by the Zonta Club of Cheyenne. According to the Cheyenne Club,

"Ray is the quiet leader and inspiration behind Climb Wyoming, one of the nation's most successful programs helping to move single mothers from poverty to self sufficiency. She began this program in the early 1980s in Cheyenne, WY and eventually brought it under her umbrella in Fleming Associates, a well recognized local provider in behavioral health services. Ray designed training, support and education to deliver wrap-around services, including life skills, mental health services, job training, job placement, and ongoing support following graduation. After more than 30 years of hard work by Ray, her 1980 summer program is now Climb Wyoming, a successful national model and vibrant statewide program with six locations working with employers around the State to meet our workforce needs, but even more importantly, to break a persistent cycle of generational poverty for women and their children."

Ray will tell us more about her program during dinner on Saturday night at the Conference.

Voting and Proxy Rules

Conference Voting Members

The voting members of the district conference shall be the governor, lieutenant governor, area directors, treasurer and the delegates of each club in good standing.

a) Clubs

Each club shall be entitled to one delegate and one alternate. If, as of the date specified by the district for the payment of district dues (Article XIII, Section 5), the membership of any club exceeds 30 members, the club shall be entitled to a second delegate and alternate. If the membership exceeds 60 members, the club shall be entitled to a third delegate and alternate.

Delegates and alternates shall be elected by the club they represent. A delegate may carry more than one of the total votes to which the club is entitled. A member of the District Board shall not be a club delegate or alternate.

(b) Proxies

A club may be represented by proxy at a district conference. A club represented by proxy shall be entitled to its total votes by proxy. No club may be represented by proxy at more than two consecutive conferences. A club may carry the proxy votes from no more than two other clubs except that the total votes carried by one club may not exceed five.

(c) Quorum

A majority of voting members registered at Conference shall constitute a quorum.

District 12 Members,

Candidates by floor nomination have always been welcome at District 12 Conferences. The procedure is as follows:

Nominations may be offered from the floor during the District Conference when nominations are called for by the Governor. Candidates to be nominated from the floor shall possess the qualifications required for the position for which they are running. They shall submit to the Chairman of the District Nominating Committee, at least five days (5) prior to the first business session of the Conference (September 16, 2019), a completed Candidate Information Form for Nominations from the Floor and a photograph. The form must also be signed by the nominator, who must be a Zontian in good standing. The form can be found on the District 12 website in the Members Only Area, under District 12 Conferences. Upon review of all submitted nomination forms and a determination that the candidates meet the qualifications required, the Chairman of the District Nominating Committee shall inform the Governor of the potential floor candidates.

PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO THE POLICIES AND PROCEDURES MANUAL OF ZONTA INTERNATIONAL DISTRICT 12

The following are the relevant provisions of the Policies and Procedures Manual for District 12. The words to be deleted or substituted are crossed out and the proposed wording with changes and/or additions are underlined on the right hand side.

There are a total of eight (8) proposals. They are grouped together as appropriate, with reference to the applicable Manual division. Page numbers refer to the "District 12 Policies and Procedures Manual," as revised in 2017.

1. Article II, District Board; Part A, Board of Directors; Section 4(1), p. 9:

PRESENT WORDING

- 1. Officers' terms shall officially commence after the close of the International Convention following their election. The term of office shall be two (2) years or until a successor takes office. No member who has served previously as an elected officer is eligible to serve in the same office again except
- a. the Treasurer who is eligible to serve two (2) consecutive terms in that office; and
- b. an area director who is eligible to serve again four(4) years after the completion of the area director's first term in that office. An officer who has served more than half a term is considered to have served a full term in that office.

PROPOSED WORDING

- 1. Officers' terms shall officially commence after the close of the International Convention following their election. The term of office shall be two (2) years or until a successor takes office. No member who has served previously as an elected officer is eligible to serve in the same office again except
- a. the Treasurer who is eligible to serve two (2) consecutive terms in that office; and
- b. an area director who is eligible to serve again four(4) years after the completion of the area director's first term in that office. An officer who has served more than half a term is considered to have served a full term in that office.

RATIONALE: The proposed change brings the D-12 Policies and Procedures Manual into conformity with changes made to the Zonta International Bylaws in 2018. The change removes the requirement that a District treasurer who serves two terms must serve consecutively

If there is no elected Vice Area Director or the Vice Area Director is unable or unwilling to serve, the vacancy shall be filled from the same Area by appointment by the Governor, with the approval of the District Board.
- d. <u>Vice Area Director</u>. Vacancy in the position of Vice Area Director shall be filled from the same Area by appointment by the Governor, with the approval of the District Board.
- e. <u>Treasurer</u>. Vacancy in the office of Treasurer shall be filled by appointment by the Governor, with approval from the District Board.
- f. <u>Secretary</u>. Vacancy in the office of Secretary shall be filled by appointment of the Governor.

PROPOSED WORDING

- (2) The vacancy may be filled by a mail ballot, provided the candidate receives a majority vote of the clubs in the District district voting members, as defined in Art.IV, Part E, (1)(a); or
- (3) The vacancy may be filled by appointment by the Governor, with the approval of the District Board.
- c. Area Director. Vacancy in the office of Area Director shall be filled by the elected Vice Area Director. If there is no elected Vice Area Director or the Vice Area Director is unable or unwilling to serve, the vacancy shall be filled from the same Area by appointment by the Governor, with the approval of the District Board.
- d. <u>Vice Area Director</u>. Vacancy in the position of Vice Area Director shall be filled from the same Area by appointment by the Governor, with the approval of the District Board.
- e. <u>Treasurer</u>. Vacancy in the office of Treasurer shall be filled by appointment by the Governor, with approval from the District Board.
- f. <u>Secretary</u>. Vacancy in the office of Secretary shall be filled by appointment of the Governor.

RATIONALE: The proposed change brings the D-12 Policies and Procedures Manual into conformity with changes made to the Zonta International Bylaws in 2018. The proposed change makes it clear that club delegates, not the entire club membership, is responsible for voting for a new lieutenant governor, in the event of a vacancy in the office..

The District Board may also submit a proposal to the District Conference in the same manner.
- d. If a majority of the voting members and proxies at the District Conference adopts the proposal, the District Secretary shall submit the proposal to the Zonta International Bylaws and Resolutions Committee within thirty (30) days after the Conference.

RATIONALE: The proposed change brings the D-12 Policies and Procedures Manual into conformity with changes made to the Zonta International Bylaws in 2018. The proposed change eliminates the words "and proxies" from the quorum necessary at District Conference to adopt a proposal for amendment of the Zonta International Bylaws or Rules of Procedure. Since proxies are voting members at the District Conference, they are included in the term and need not be separately distinguished.
