

We haven't met but have had good electronic communication with advocates, officer and agencies. We provided help to 2 victims/survivors this year Clothing - \$208 and Airplane ticket- \$183 The great project idea we were researching involving brining Care Portal (online contributors matched with advocate needs) is on hold. So – lots of opportunity and need to get going again the second we see lights at the end of this 'distance year'.

SART High School Peer Counselor program consists of high school student becoming peer counselors for Middle School girls and boys under Title IX for 90 minutes one day a year. Curriculum is designed to empower youth to avoid sexual harassment/sexual assault behaviors and support the development of healthy relationships in both genders. The program has trained 80 peer counselors. The Zonta Club of Greeley and SAVA/SART project was started in 2014 and is temporarily on hold in six local high schools.
