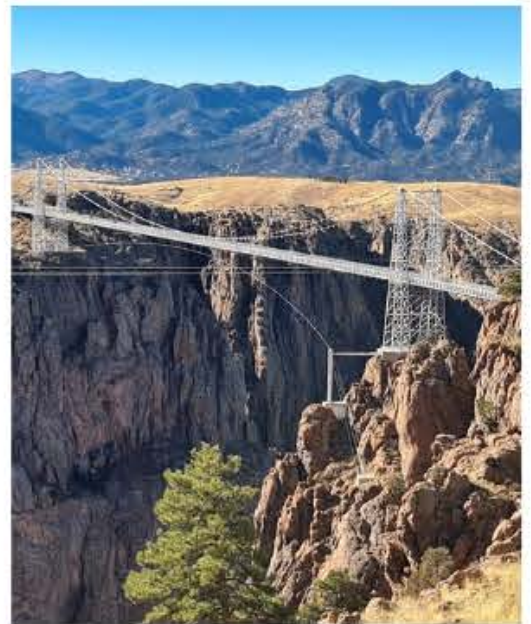

Colorado/Wyoming clubs help Ukraine Refugees.



Zonta club of Fort Collins President, Julie Trone, organized a necessities drive after attending the Zonta International convention in Hamburg, Germany. Fifteen boxes were packed with donations from the Fort Collins, Greeley and Cheyenne clubs. 7,000 sanitary pads, 400 pair of underwear, 250 bras, and boxes of warm sweaters, shirts, and jackets. Cash donations arrived to pay for shipping costs. Boxes arrived in Poland in late September and after much struggle on to Lviv, Ukraine arriving the morning of Thanksgiving.



In "Invisible Women: Exposing Data Bias in a World Designed by Men" Caroline Criado-Pérez investigates the root cause of gender inequality, diving into women's lives at home, the workplace, the public square, the doctor's office, and more.
