Non-Traditional Open Scholarship

The deadline for applying to the scholarship is April 1st of each year.

The following items must be submitted:

- 2. Two letters of recommendation.
- 3. Your personal letter stating qualifications and career goals & your vision of helping empowering women.
- 4. A resume listing all activities, awards, honors, employment, volunteer work, and offices held.

You may be asked to interview with the Scholarship Committee.
