# Winterize Your Home

- Let the sun stream in south-facing windows
- Cover drafty windows with heavy-duty, clear plastic
- Find and seal leaks on the exterior of the home
- Winterize your car
- Maintain your heating system
- Keep the fireplace damper closed when not in use
- Change water temperature to warm (120 degrees)
- Use LED or solar holiday string lights, look for Energy Star
- Adjust the thermostat - 68-70 degrees when home and lower at night (65-67 degrees)
- Dress for the weather and the temperature inside and out
