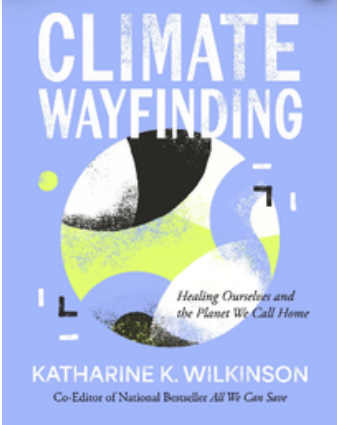

She taught them how to organize the various pictorial elements they envisioned and how to show women’s contributions to the history of the West. A long-time Laramie resident, originally from Australia, compared their work to Aboriginal Australian art. He felt the mural showed the need for feminine balance in nature and was quite poetic about the female symbolism of the flowers in the sky. They also learned from a public artist who taught them that creating public art and goal-setting by young women are both important and necessary. The Z-Club of Laramie High School created a beautiful historic element to adorn their school walls and recreated her story (history).
